Background:

The principles in terms of which judges and arbitrators may receive evidence differ materially. Unlike judges, arbitrators are not shackled with the obligation to apply the strict rules of evidence as a matter of course. The discussion will focus on the reasons behind and the ambit of an arbitrator's discretionary powers when receiving opinion evidence, including expert opinion evidence.
