#### ABOUT THE WORKSHOP:

Adjudication is an accelerated form of dispute resolution. A neutral third party decides the dispute as an expert, not as an arbitrator. The adjudicator’s determination is immediately enforceable as a contractual obligation. Adjudication, generally, will be considered. What is the nature of the process: is it inquisitorial or adversarial, do the rules of natural justice apply, should there be legal representation, are counterclaims permissible? There will be a case study of a “determination” to demonstrate how various issues can be addressed, like multiple disputes, counterclaims and the impact of a prior determination.
